Purpose of the TEC II programme



to enhance capacity of Thai private and public sector organisations in support of national development goals in:

- a) trade and investment;**
- b) higher education and science-technology;**
- c) environment, climate change, energy; and**
- d) good governance**



Mechanisms for achieving the goals of **TEC II**



1) **Demand-driven approach**

- Funds delivered through competitive Calls for Proposals
- Open to eligible Thailand-based organisations
- Small, limited-duration projects
- Strategic importance and of interest to Thailand
- 1 Call for Proposals with **ONE deadline** on **25 May 2010** with total EU funding of **€2.4 million**.

2) **Tender for Services** - Support to **Policy Dialogue** through Technical Assistance (TA) **€2.0 million**



Results of the Call for Proposals



8 grants were awarded

Lot 1: 3 projects (€22,305)

Lot 2: 2 projects (€79,920)

Lot 3: 3 projects (€99,731)

Total EU contribution: **€2,399,956**

- Enhancing Food Safety Management Competence in the Thai "Ready to Eat" Food Sector
- Trade Standard Compliance and Innovations for Agri-Food Supply Chains in Thailand and Neighbouring Countries
